TK/Kindergarten Registration

~ Parent Information for School Year 2017-18 ~

Welcome to Western Placer Unified School District! We are delighted that your child will be joining us for Transitional Kindergarten or Kindergarten next year. We hope the information below will assist you in completing your child's TK/Kindergarten registration process:

Guidelines to Assist the TK/Kindergarten Registration Process:

- A child must turn 5 on or before September 1, 2017 to be eligible for kindergarten for the coming year.
 - 2017/18 – 5 years of age on or before September 1st
- We will be offering Transitional Kindergarten (TK) for students with birthdays who turn 5 (five) on or between September 2 and December 31, 2017. TK is the first year of a two-year Kindergarten program for children with fall birthdays. For students who are too young for Transitional Kindergarten or Kindergarten, please see the WPUSD Preschool flyer for alternative suggestions.
- TK/Kindergarten registration will occur at individual elementary school sites
- Parents may pick up TK/Kindergarten Registration packets at their child's school site beginning February 28, 2017.
- **Parents may return completed packets to school sites beginning Tuesday, March 7, 2017 (not before), with the exception of Lincoln Crossing Elementary School which will accept completed packets beginning Monday March 6, 2017 (not before).**
- Required Immunization information will be included in the TK/Kindergarten Registration packet:
 - Immunizations must be current when registration materials are turned in.
 - If only the FINAL required immunization (Polio, DTP, MMR) is incomplete, the school will accept the packet, but the child will not be enrolled in a class until all the immunizations are complete.
 - Any exceptions to this must be approved by the District Nurse.
 - **Required Immunizations:**
 - **DTP** – 5 doses (4 doses are acceptable if the 4th dose has been given on or after the 4th birthday)
 - **Polio** – 4 doses (3 doses are acceptable if the 3rd dose has been given on or after the 4th birthday)
 - **Hepatitis B** – 3 doses
 - **MMR** – 2 doses
 - **Varicella** – 1 dose
