8.3 Information **LETTER FROM PCOE REGARDING WPUSD'S 2010-11 ADOPTED BUDGET** – **Lopes** (10-11 G & O Component I, IV, V)

•In accordance with the provisions of AB 1200 and Education Code Section 42127, prior to approving district budgets, the County Superintendent of schools is required to review the Board adopted budget to determine if it meets the criteria and standards for fiscal stability. PCOE has completed their review of Western Placer Unified School District's 2010-11 Board of Trustees adopted budget, has approved the budget and has noted concerns.

Joyce Lopes reported the County approved the adopted budget but noted some concerns with deficit spending and multi year projections. Joyce Lopes reported she would present unaudited financials at the next board meeting, and the district is preparing for an annual audit.

Mr. Long reported we need to look at the free and reduce law. He shared one of the young ladies that spoke earlier was his granddaughter, and he is very proud of her.


Mr. Carras talked about the football game.


