Mr. Leaman introduced Twelve Bridges Principal, Stacey Brown. Mr. Brown reviewed the programs that were being presented.

Ms. Campbell introduced Leadership Officers. Karlie Medeiros, Student Body President, reported on student council; Charlie Landon, Treasurer, he reported his jobs are balancing AST budget, fundraisers, activities, dances, they are all to help support the school. Todd Scott, ASB Secretary, he spoke about invisible students, he reported his roll and all that is done to guide these students. Vice President, Brianna Mattal, Student Body, Time Management, Leadership is a very important, and currently with 36 students in Leadership, Budget Management helps students get involved.

Denise Sterns, PTC Treasurer, she has been an officer three years on the board at TBMS. She handles volunteers; movie night; currently working on the October 29<sup>th</sup> golf tournament; Old Pasta Dinner Night on Nov. 9<sup>th</sup>; and the BBQ Lunch at the LHS Farm. Fundraisers have provided for teachers needs, which include Transportation; science class supplies; books for 7<sup>th</sup> grade classes; and document cameras for classrooms. They've risen over \$10,000 in the last couple of years.

Science Teachers will share the Philosophy of Science in the middle school grades. The following teachers participated in the presentation: 7<sup>th</sup> grade Science Teachers, Ms. Ford, Ms. Hladum, and 8<sup>th</sup> grade Science Teachers, Ms. Amalong, and Ms. Mosbacher. 7.2 Western Placer Teacher's Association – Mike Agrippino thanked everyone for all they have done for Glen Edwards. On behalf of the WPTA he shared significant budget issues that will affect students and staff, and hopes for broader perspectives, and plans on taking an active roll in the budget.

7.3 Western Placer Classified Employee Association – Mike Kimbrough also spoke on behalf of the Budget, on behalf the CSEA. CSEA is thankful to the board and Mr. Leaman for saving classified jobs. They hope everyone can work together towards keeping jobs.

7.4 Superintendent - Scott Leaman reported the following:

- Update on the Glen Edwards Fire that happened last week. He commended the staff at Glen Edwards. We have found places for everyone on campus, and stabilized the situation. Extensive environmental testing is being done, insurance is on board looking at what needs to be replaced, and we have had a pretty heavy presence on campus from the district office. He shared how hard it is to experience something like that, and commended the cleanup crew for doing a fantastic job. Many members were involved, and we will continue to work on the situation and keep the board updated. The district has sent out extensive emails to the staff to keep them updated on the situation, as well as phone messages to parents.




